



The Artist covenants and agrees as follows

- 1. General Conditions:** The Artist warrants and represents that he/she is the sole creator of the work of art signed by him/her and entered in the competition. That the work of art is an original creation and does not infringe upon any other person's copyright or rights of artistic property, nor to his/her knowledge does it violate the rights of privacy of other persons. The Artists agrees to indemnify the Alaska Artists Guild (AAG) and its affiliated partners of this competition, against any final judgment for damages in any lawsuit, out of court settlement or other agreed settlement with any other party based on actual breach of artist's warranties or representations above. In the event of any lawsuit the artist agrees to pay the AAG any costs and attorney fees incurred in defending such a law suit. In the event a lawsuit is brought which may result in the artist having been held to have breached his/her warranties under this agreement, the AAG shall have the right to withhold and place in escrow any sums payable to the artist for works sold by Aurora Fine Art Gallery or AAG, but in no event may such with holding exceed the damage alleged in the complaint.
- 2. Royalty Payment to Artist:** Aurora Fine Art Gallery will receive a commission of **50%** from sales of ORIGINAL artwork. Artist will be paid **50%** of sales price with in 30 days of sale.
- 3. Display and Sale of Original Art:** Best in Show will be used by AAG for promotion and advertising of future shows/contests. **25 prints** will be made to use as AAG limited editions with all proceeds going to AAG for promotion of future shows and education, and will be available during the month of April after the show. All art in the April show will be on display the entire month of April. All unsold paintings must be picked up by the Artist at the end of the month of April.
- 4. Ownership of Original Art:** The Artist will retain ownership of the original artwork. If said artwork is sold, the Artist will retain the copyright to the original artwork, subject to the AAG's exclusive reproduction rights to use the paintings as outlined in Paragraph 3 above.
- 5. Termination:** This agreement shall continue in effect for one (1) year from the date of the Final Judging.
- 6. Benefits:** The benefits of this agreement shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, successors, and assigns of the respective parties.
- 7. Loss or Damage:** AAG will not be responsible for loss or damage no matter what the cause. By submitting artwork to this exhibition, each artist will be deemed to have concurred with this agreement.
- 8. Time-line of Event:** Entry deadline is March 21st, 2020. Artists may drop off accepted artwork between noon and 6:00 pm. at Aurora Fine Art Gallery.
- 9.** AAG will award ribbons after judging and cash prizes will be available for artists to pick up at the event
