Graham Dane Workshop

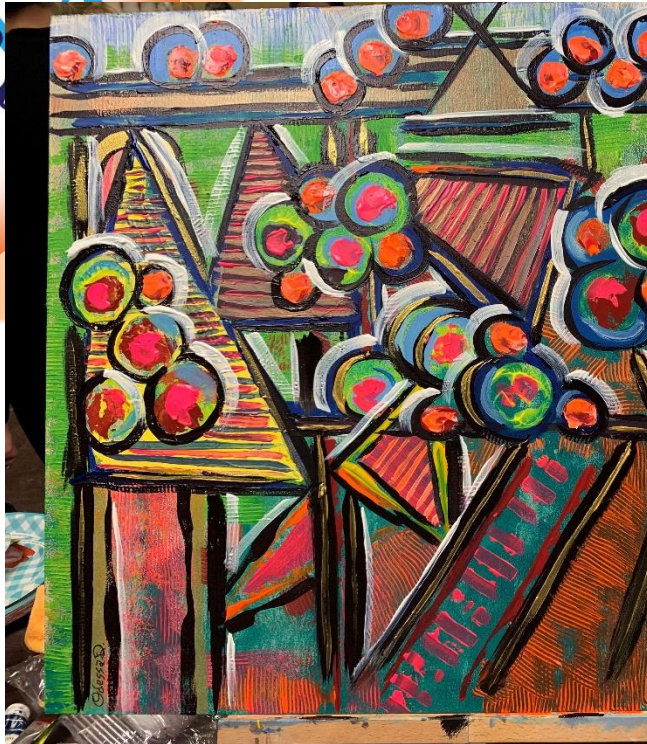
The workshop with Graham Dane was very educational and successful!

AAG October 4th Members Show

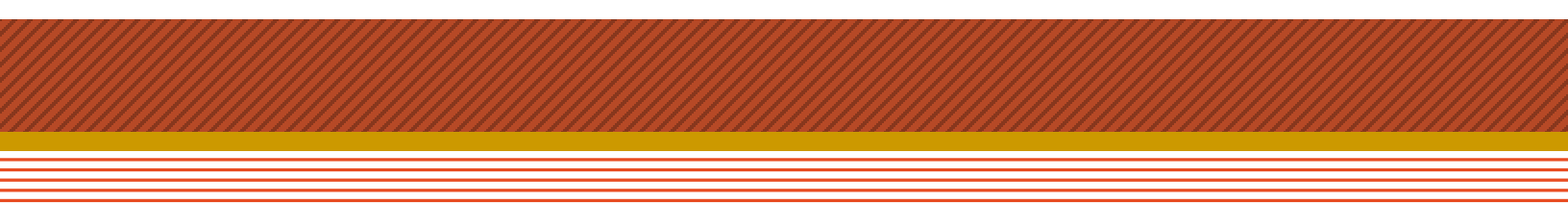
The talented Whitney Youngman will be performing at the show
